





### Genesis









### Sexual activity

• In 2018, approximately 1 in 4 grade 10 students report they have had sexual intercourse

 Of the students who report having had sex, most had their first experience when they were 15 years old

 "It is More Normal Today as a Teenager to Engage in Sexual Activity Than Not to"


• In the senior high group 69.2% agree, 25.8% are unsure/don't know, and 5% disagree with this statement

### Porn

"A Canadian study done with 470 adolescents reported that 98% of them had been exposed to pornography; the average age of first exposure was around 12 years"

### Porn

"In 2017 alone, Pornhub has <mark>78.1 million visitors a day"</mark>

"75% of Canada's traffic is made by way of mobile devices"

### Sexting

"41% (4 in ten) of youth aged 16 to 20 had sent one or more sexts"

# SOGI in BC Schools in BC

### SOGI

**Sexual orientation:** refers to physical or emotional attraction that one feels for another person

**Gender identity:** One's internal and psychological sense of oneself as a man, woman, both, in-between, neither, or another understanding of gender


There is no "SOGI curriculum." However, throughout K-12 curriculum and school activities, students and teachers explore the topic of human rights and:

- What it means to value diversity and respect differences
- How to respond to discrimination


Teachers may include discussions around the B.C. Human Rights Code, sexual orientation and gender identity.

SOGI 1 2 3 is a resource that supports educators in addressing these topics in the provincial curriculum. It helps schools create safe, caring and inclusive learning environments for all students regardless of their race, culture, religion, sexual orientation or gender identity and expression. Educators are not required to use this resource.








#### School in BC- Erickson Elementary School in Creston, B.C.

#### Sexual content in media

Researchers surveyed 684 top grossing movies from 1998 to 2004.

More than 84% of these movies contained sexual content

"Adolescents who are exposed to more sexual content in movies start having sex at younger ages, have more sexual partners, and are less likely to use condoms with casual sexual partners"

•You need to start from early age (e.g., 4 years old)


Use ageappropriate language




Our Children don't care how much we know until they know how we care
